# **OpenShift on IBM Power Virtual** Servers

For the last month I have been part of an IBM PoC testing Red Hat OpenShift version 4 on PowerVS. The testing has gone smoothly so hopefully IBM will be officially announcing support in December. In the meantime we will be giving an overview at the next ASEAN Power AIX/i/Linux Meetup (see below).

## **IBM Spectrum Scale Alert : mmfsck command option causes new mount failure**

IBM just released an alert relating to Spectrum Scale / GPFS versions 5.0.4.0 to 5.0.4.4 and 5.0.5.0 to 5.0.5.3 (ESS versions 5.3.5 to 5.3.6.1 or 6.0.0.0 to 6.0.1.1), where running mmfsck with the --estimate-only option while the file system is online causes new mounts to fail and other potential access problems.

It is recommended to upgrade to V5.0.5.4, or if not possible, contact IBM support for efix -APAR IJ27414. In the meantime, it is recommended not to run this option (There is a work around if you find yourself in this situation).

**Vulnerabilities in NTPv4 affect AIX** It was found that ntpd in ntp before 4.2.8p14 and 4.3.x before 4.3.100 allows an off-path attacker to block unauthenticated synchronisation via a server mode packet with a spoofed source IP address, because transmissions are rescheduled even when a packet lacks a valid origin timestamp. AIX 7.1, 7.2 and VIOS 3.1 are affected.

#### IBM AIX APAR: IJ29419 - NPIV boot failure with 554 after upgrading to 7200-05-01-2038

If a system has been upgraded to 7.2.05.01 and uses NPIV for boot it's LUNs, boot could fail with error 554 as the vfc adapters fail to configure correctly.
